1 September Cottage. High Street.
(Behind the Sandrock). Pam Roy-Jones 
Cottage garden with shaped beds containing colourful
planting, mainly perennials. Excellent Downs views.

2 4 The Dymocks. Caroline Senior 
Pretty cottage garden with meandering paths around
varied mature planting, seating areas & koi pond. Lots
of inspirational ideas on what can be done with a small

3 Pardons. 78 East End Lane.  
John & Susie Godley
Historic, tranquil walled garden, deep planted borders,
wildlife pond & unique 18th Century belvedere and
some pretty roses. REFRESHMENTS.


4 Aspin. Farm Lane. Graeme & Lorna Hemsley 
Large garden laid out in a formal manner. Pathways
around shrubs and perennials with a water feature.

5 Lichen House. Farm Lane.
Claire & Andrew McQuillan
Family garden with views of the Downs. Pond and patio,
vegetable planting and extensive borders with unusual
plants. Pergola wrapped with a mature Wisteria.

6 Beardsland. 97 Lewes Road.   
Lynn & Clive Bush 
A garden with seating areas, lawns, borders & raised
beds with colourful flower, fruit and vegetable planting.
A large wildlife field with views of the Downs.
Disabled parking on site. REFRESHMENTS.

7 12 South View. Tim & Ruth Gaskell  
A heavy clay soil garden, with roses & a wide range of
flowering plants used to inspire the owners' painting
and art classes. ART FOR SALE.

8 13 South View. Tessa Chisholm & Taravajara 
Meandering cottagey garden, planting packed with
colour, texture, movement & drama. A wild patch, cosy
seating areas, wildlife pond & quirky cabin for shelter.

Veryan Greenwood & Philip Dunn
Formal planting, interspersed with wild flowers and
dotted with sculptures. Beautiful pump-led stream,
